



KASPER, Kids After School Program of Education and Recreation, is a local non-profit community group formed in 2008 that is committed to providing Brookings-Harbor youth with an educational and fun experience in a safe environment through after-school and summer programs. Our goal is to prevent latchkey children and provide opportunities for all children, regardless of family income, with the opportunity to explore music, recreation and art. The KASPER summer program serves 50-60 children each season and grows annually. In 2010, KASPER began a partnership with 4-H, and it has proven to be beneficial for both parties, offering even more possibilities and experiences to the children in our community.

Over the years, KASPER and their Program Directors have led hundreds of volunteers in sharing their time and talents with local kids who get to experience things they might not otherwise have an opportunity for such as learning music, gardening, arts and crafts, science, nature, dance, community involvement, ecology, and finding the adventures in reading!

KASPER has supported their mission primarily through a live and silent auction gala called *The Barnacle Ball*. The money raised is used for quality program staff, field trips, supplies, operating expenses, healthy snacks, and scholarships. KASPER has also benefited from grants including Community 101, Wild Rivers Community Foundation, the Gordon Elwood Foundation Award, and other generous community donations.
